

Crowes Line Beach





Nogies Creek Cemetery

GPS: 44°34.493'N 78°30.771'W In 1852 William Ventress, an early settler of the area, bought a piece of land west of the mouth of Nogies Creek. Later, he donated part of his land to be used as a cemetery. Originally known as the Ventress Burying Ground, it was operational from 1865-1952. Some of the original headstones remain and through extensive research the names of those buried in this pioneer cemetery were determined and listed on the memorial
