


# Short-term Renters

## Waste Management Guide



**We do not have curbside pick up in Trent Lakes.** You need to take your garbage and recycling to one of our four Transfer Station Sites.



Visitors to the area will need to use a **“One Time Waste Disposal Pass”** that is included in the Cottage Kit in order to enter any Trent Lakes Transfer Station.



**One (1) bag of garbage in a clear bag is** permitted per One Time Waste Disposal Pass. Additional bags of garbage will be subject to a fee. Clear garbage bags are mandatory.



**Recycling is mandatory.** You must sort your blue box recycling into Containers and Fibres. You can drop off unlimited recycling.

## Recycling for Containers

Rinse all containers and ensure they are clean of liquids or food



Plastic bottles, tubs, containers (caps can be left on)



Metal beverage cans, metal food cans



Aluminum foil and trays



Cartons



Paper beverage cups



Glass bottles and jars



Plastic plant pots and trays (no soil)



Cardboard canisters

## Recycling for Fibres



Boxboard



Newspapers



Magazines & Catalogues



Paper (office, mixed, writing)



Plastic bags (clean, dry, empty)



Corrugated cardboard (flatten)



Brown paper bags



Paper egg cartons, paper take-out trays



Toilet paper rolls, Paper towel rolls

## Garbage

Must be placed in clear garbage bags



Bubble wrap packaging



Cookie, chip, snack bags and wrappers



Plastic straws, plastic cutlery



Broken ceramics



Disposable gloves, masks, sanitizing wipes



Food and beverage pouches
